Québec will table Budget 2021-2022 on March 25

Québec City, March 9, 2021 – Minister of Finance Eric Girard today announced that the Québec government will table Budget 2021-2022 on March 25, 2021. On the same day, Minister Responsible for Government Administration and Chair of the Conseil du trésor Sonia Lebel will table the 2021-2022 Expenditure Budget and the 2021-2031 Québec Infrastructure Plan.

Given the ongoing pandemic, the traditional closed-door information session will be reserved for the media, in compliance with the health recommendations in force. The formula adopted will be communicated subsequently to the media.
